Re: Coffee Hour guidelines during a fasting period.

In keeping with our traditions as Orthodox Christians, we fast several times throughout the year. Accordingly, there are some things which ought not be served during Coffee Hour during these seasons. These include:

- Any meat products
- ❖ All dairy products including cream, cheese, cream for coffee, milk, cheeses and butter

Fasting periods are

- Great Lent, starting from Meatfare
- ❖ Apostle's Fast, starting after Pentecost until our Parish Feast Day
- Dormition Fast, August 1 to 15
- Nativity Fast, November 15 to December 25
- ❖ Holy Days: Theophany Eve, Exaltation of the Cross, Beheading of John the Baptist

Margarine and Non-Dairy Creamer are acceptable substitutes. It would be good during these times, if you are so inclined, to provide something extra, to offer fruits and vegetables and other healthy foods. 

Ephesians 5.22 - 33: Taking the Family Seriously

Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything.

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself... For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones. "For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church. Nevertheless let each one of you in particular so love his own wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.
